## ■ Corporate History

- August 1930 Started operation of Kaneko Store. Started sales of machinery tools and parts.
- October 1939 Started sheet metal press working operations.
- October 1947 Established Kaneko Seisakusho Co., Ltd. Hirochika Iimura assumed the office of representative director.
- October 1962 Started plastic molding processing operations.
- April 1965 Construction of new factory in Nagareyama industrial zone was completed. The factory started operation as Matsudo Factory.
- June 1974 Construction of new headquarters building was completed. The new headquarters commenced business.
- October 1981 Hajime Shiojima assumed the office of representative director.
- May 1983 Formed a technology alliance with US-based AT&T to introduce cable connector technologies.
- February 1985 Construction of electronics plant inside Matsudo Factory was completed. The plant started operation.
- November 1988 Increased capital to ¥16 million.
- November 1990 Increased capital to ¥32 million.
- August 1994 Formed a technology alliance with US-based Corning Incorporated to participate in the development of new materials.
- November 1994 Increased capital to ¥48 million.
- November 1996 Participated in the joint development of Thixomolding of magnesium alloys.
- October 1997 Celebrated the 50th anniversary of the company.
- August 2000 Construction of high-precision FEP resin molding plant was completed. The plant started operation.
- June 2001 Masahiro Iimura assumed the office of representative director.
- October 2001 Headquarters operations will be relocated inside Matsudo Factory in October, and the factory will become the business headquarters.
- September 2002 Start sales of Hidamari-kun, the first product developed as the company's own brand
- June 2004 Visit Vietnam for the first time, inspection of manufacturing technology etc.
- March 2005 Issued corporate bonds for 100 million yen for the first time to strengthen the financial base
- August 2005 Provided technical instructions to cooperating factory in Vietnam, the first arrival of processed goods
- October 2007 60th anniversary of the company
- January 2008 Capital investment in cooperating factory in Vietnam, relocation of all machinery and equipment
